

City Hall of Istres, South of France

The facade of Istres City Hall, located in the Provence region was up-lit in the French flag colours!

The facade is illuminated with 9 in-ground recessed **5760-Passy** LEC lightbars installed at the front + 1 on the side of the City Hall. Each lightbar measures 1-meter long and has a distance in between of 8-meters long. The luminaires are in 230V trichro and AUTODMX.

The lighting designer Atelier Roland Jeol wanted to up-light the facade with several scenarii allowing a dynamic or a static illumination. Control is made by ARAPDMX512 box.
