

## Light on the Jacobins in Lyon

After 2 years of work, the renovation of the “Place des Jacobins” main square in Lyon, was finally achieved in the summer 2013. A beautiful up-lighting was done on the fountain, in and around, as well as the surrounding square.

### On the main square:

- > 191 in-ground recessed spotlights [1750A-Bourgogne](#) in white are covering the whole square and bears a snail shape.

### Inside the fountain:

In immersion, 16 special adjustable and submersible LED spotlights were installed including:

- > 8 x [4042XX-Luminy 4](#) : 41° beam, 24VDC, 24 Superwatts 3W warm white
- > 8 x [4042XX-Luminy 4](#), (to light up the basins): 36° beam CE12-36 24VDC 12 Superwatts 3W warm white.

### Around the fountain:

- > 12 specials LED spotlights with 3 adjustable LED [1830-Lucerne](#) opened at 10°
- > 8 LED linears [5635-Ligny-CE30-10](#): 24 VDC, 30 LEDs/m, 3W switching in alternative from warm white to amber and so on.
- > 4 LED linears [5635-Ligny-CE30-10](#): 24 VDC, 30 LEDs/m, 3W in warm white
