

Pepys' Parks in Lewisham (UK)

To open up the existing space of the park "Aargon Gardens", BDP imagined a special sculpture placed on an area slightly high up within the park from which we can see the Thames river.

Its design needed to symbolize the historical nautical nature of the park.

The initial concept was inspired by the shape of the Golden Hind, the

famous English galleon.

LEDs spotlights were installed on the 5-meters high poles to up-light both the ground underneath the sculpture and the interior of the sails with:

> 5 x **4040-Luminy 4** CW12-20, 20° beam, 12 Superwatts 3W cold white

> 3 x **4040-Luminy 4** CE12-36, 36° beam, 12 Superwatts 3W warm white

> 5 x **6090S-Brive** BL3 3 Superwatts blue 1W stainless steel IP 67 spotlights for poles head 360°. These ones were placed on each pole's end and have become a landmark at night.
