

## The Halle of Grenade

### Up-lighting of the “Halle” of Grenade, South West of France

Made Historical Monument in 1979, the “Halle” of Grenade was renovated following years of restoration.

Its light enhancement is underlined with the following

LEC luminaires:

> 18 spotlights [5634-Stripe](#)-CW6-3W in cold white on the timbered indoor windows

> 8 lightbars [5633-Arches](#)-BE6-100x12 in warm white on the top timbers

> 6 spotlights [4040-Luminy 4](#)-CE12-36-3W in warm white on the indoors top facades

> 144 spotlights [4020-Luminy 2](#)-CW-10-3W in cold white installed at the top of the pillars. The spotlights were anodised in black.
